Description: The Office of the Attorney General is seeking an Assistant Attorney General to represent the Department of Housing and Community Development (“Department”) in litigation, personnel, Public Information Act (“PIA”), and procurement matters. The Department is the State’s housing and community development finance agency. The type of litigation in which the Department typically is involved includes tort claims, real property disputes, section 8 housing choice voucher program termination actions, personnel disputes, breach of contract actions, and other miscellaneous litigation matters. The Assistant Attorney General in this position may practice before the District and Circuit Courts of Maryland, the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, the Office of Administrative Hearings, the Maryland Commission on Civil Rights, the Equal Employment Opportunities Commission, the Public Service Commission, and the Maryland State Board of Contract Appeals. Responsibilities also include assisting the Department in responding to PIA requests, drafting and reviewing contracts (including procurement contracts and inter-agency agreements), and advising on PIA, procurement, and personnel matters.

Experience: The ideal candidate will have five years general litigation experience and admission to the Maryland Bar. Experience with public information act, personnel, and procurement law helpful.
