



Public Works Maintenance Technician

The City of Glenarden is seeking an experienced Maintenance Technician I or II to assist in the maintaining the City's streets and landscapes.

PRIMARY FUNCTIONS

- Conducts routine equipment maintenance which includes greasing, changing oil, rotating/replacing tires, and regular preventative maintenance
- Maintains lawn, flowers and plants at parks, which involves mowing and trimming the lawn, fertilizing and laying sod and watering weekly. Plant new landscaping and trims trees where necessary.
- Provides minor repairs to City buildings when required.
- Provides custodial service daily for entire building.
- Performs minor electrical and plumbing repair.
- Removes snow from City building sidewalks and steps as needed by shoveling first aid applying salt.
- Monitors and maintains streets daily to check for litter, street signs, animal control, potholes and other issues.

The applicant must be able to perform highly physical outdoor activities for an extensive period of time. Skills and abilities to use lawn equipment, drive a light duty truck, lift heavy equipment up to 60 pounds. Position requires carrying, lifting, bending, walking and shoveling. The individual with building and facilities work experience desirable. Six months progressively responsible experience in a related field is required for a Maintenance Technician I and two years of progressively responsible experience in a related field is required for the Maintenance Technician II position.

Candidates must be 18 years of age or older to operate equipment and have a high school diploma or GED. In addition, must possess a C class driver's license and a clean driving record.
